She has always been an exceptional beacon of can-do attitude, drive, passion, laughter and such sharp intellect and such a dedicated visionary realizing what many people live as dreams with.”

“Benay was my coach when I moved to Bali, she was formation in the content I still use today. So grateful for the impact she had on my life.”

“She added so much to so many lives and was so beautiful and joyous. The time i spent being part of her coaching group was one of the best things i ever did.”
