He loved the festivals' ability to show a variety of genres and wide range of artist from up and coming to established acts in one location. He treasured the time he saw Paul McCartney perform at Austin City Limits. He enjoyed cooking with his dad and on his own. He made the best pancakes ever. He also enjoyed losing himself in the magical universes of fantasy novels and movies.

He graduated from Chapin High School's Pre-Engineering Magnet program in 2017 in El Paso, Texas. He received a B.S. in Computer Science with a minor in Math from the University of Houston in 2022.

Antonio is survived by his parents Fernando Urias and Sandra C. Urias, his brother Fernando Urias-Cordero, his paternal grandmother, and many aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends.

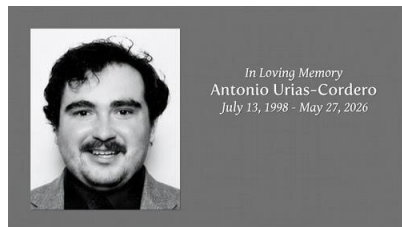
