Dohrman Paul Wright died Tuesday, Feb. 6, 2018, peacefully in the arms of his wife of 38 years, at home in The Woodlands, Texas.

Dohrman was born May 18, 1930, in Franklin, Pa., the son of Dohrman and Beatrice Wright. He was the oldest of four children. He earned a bachelor's degree from Cleveland State University in Ohio, and he served in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War.
