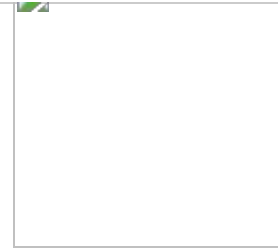

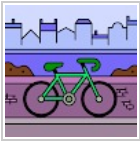

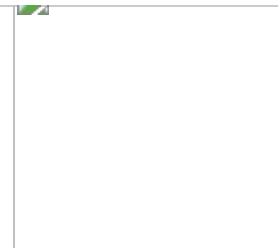

Your passing was such a shock to all of us. You were an amazing friend, husband, and father, and your presence will truly be missed by so many.

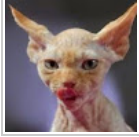

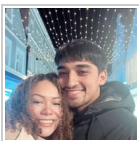
