James "Jimmy" Warren Williams passed away peacefully into the arms of Our Lord on Thursday morning, October 23, 2025 at his home at the age of 81.

He was born at Heights Hospital in Houston, Texas to Henry Marcus Williams and Annie Lou Moore. He was the youngest of nine children.

He attended elementary school and Hogg Junior High School in the Heights. The family moved across town where he graduated from Jesse H Jones High School. He graduated from the Houston Police Academy in November of 1965 and served the City of Houston as a police officer for 38 years. He bowled in several leagues, enjoyed playing cards and working crossword puzzles. Jimmy enjoyed attending various sporting events and other activities his children and grandchildren participated in all over Texas and beyond.
