



Jerauld Lollar Hill

Jerauld Lollar Hill passed away peacefully on May 22, 2015. A memorial service will be held at St. John the Divine Episcopal Church, 2450 River Oaks Boulevard, on Friday, May 29, 2015 at three'clock in the afternoon following a private interment at Glenwood Cemetery. A reception will follow in Sumner's Hall at the church.

"Jerry" was born in Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania on March 22, 1931 to Ruth Jerauld and John Henry Lollar, Jr. The Lollar family moved to Houston in 1940. Following her graduation from The Kinkaid School, Jerry attended Bennett Junior College in Millbrook, NY. In 1949, she was presented as a debutante of the season at the historic Saturn Club in Buffalo, NY, the home of her aunt and uncle. She graduated from Bennett in 1951, just months before marrying the love of her life, Raymond Monroe Hill of Houston on September 15, 1951. Together they raised four children and were married for 61 years. Jerry will always be remembered for her warm heart and her beautiful smile.
