Linda Ebeling, born and raised in New Orleans, Louisiana, peacefully passed away August 27, 2021 in Houston, Texas following a coronary episode. She was preceded in death by her parents, Pete and Ruth Ebeling, and brother Peter, Jr.

Linda was attractive, gregarious, often opinionated and outspoken, and ardently independent. Linda was an avid sports fan, especially for the Houston Texans.
