



## Thomas Richard Noser

June 3, 1938 - March 17, 2022

Thomas “Tom” Richard Noser, 83, went home to be with the Lord on March 17, 2022. Born in 1938 in Lake Charles, Louisiana, Tom was the third of six children born to Walter Peter Noser and Lillian Watson Noser.

Tom was a loving husband, father, and grandfather who was very active in his church as a lector, cantor, choir member, member of the guitar music ministry, and the Knights of Columbus. Tom served in the Marine Reserves in the early 60’s and was a structural draftsman for the early part of his career prior to running his own cabinetry and handyman business in the 80’s, 90’s, 2000’s. Tom was a member of the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) and was passionate about airplanes.
