Tonatiuh Butron, born on September 25, 1968 as a twin, to Pedro Antonio and Laura Butron, died on December 25, 2025 in Houston, Texas. Tonatiuh is preceded in death by his father, Pedro Antonio Butron. 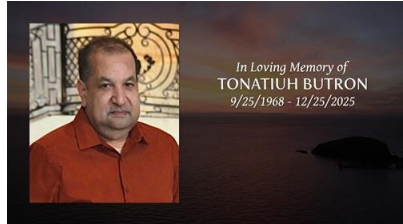

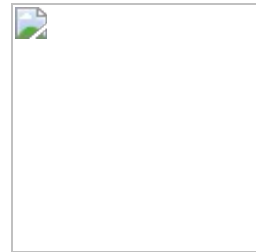

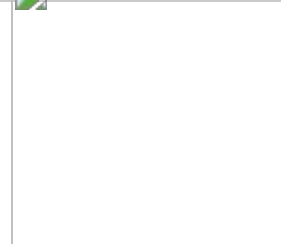
